<b>Participant Fee</b>	<p>The fee to participate includes two nights of accommodation, all meals &amp; refreshments, meeting sessions, and online access to materials.</p> <p>The fee is €3,295 + 20% VAT. The total amount payable, inclusive of VAT, is €3,954.</p> <p>Participants are expected to stay at the Château Mont Royal during the <i>Forum</i>, as the interplay with the group is an important part of the benefit to all concerned.</p> <p>Please note that the <i>Forum</i> is limited up to 48 participants. <b>Cancellation</b>	<p>Registrations are non-transferable.
